

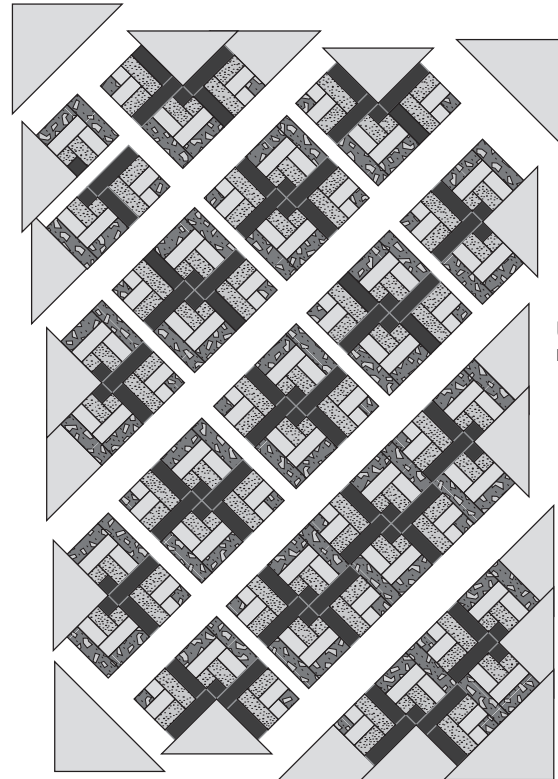
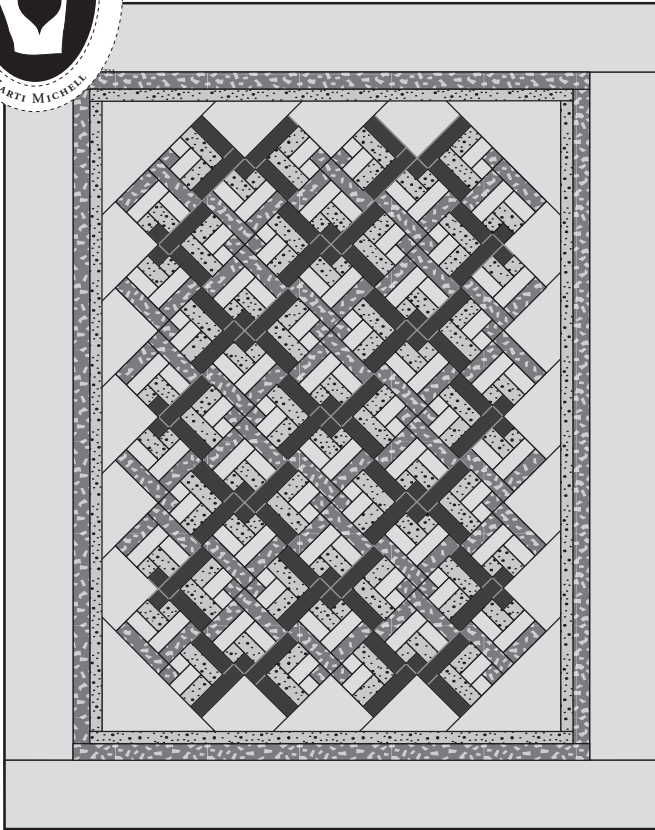


Linked Chevron

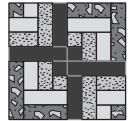

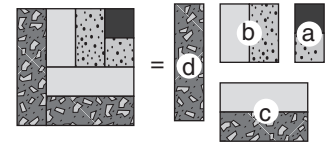

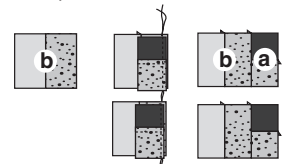

Piecing Chevron Blocks

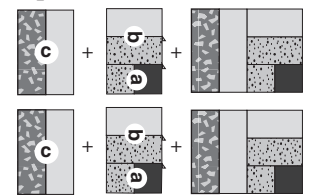
Unit A shown



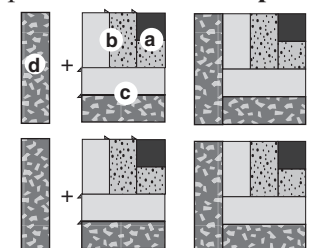
Chain piece strip sets **1:2** and **2:3** together, as shown:



Add strip set **3:4** in the same way:

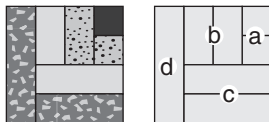


Complete Unit A with **strip 4**:

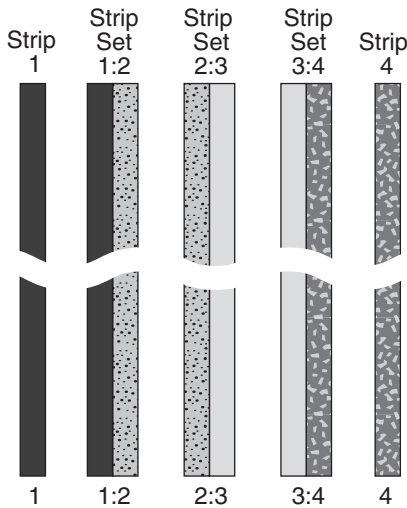


Make Unit B blocks, starting with strip set **3:4**.

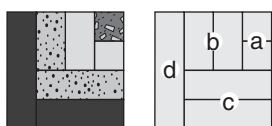

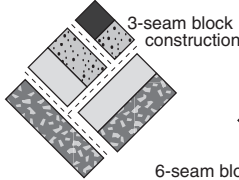

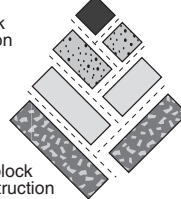

Fabric Requirements

½ yd each of 4 fabrics for Chevron strips

⅝ yd background fabric

¼, ⅜ and 1 yd for borders

Fabric for backing and binding

Batting

Log Cabin Ruler #3058 recommended

1. Cut all 4 Chevron fabrics into strips, 1¾" by 18" on lengthwise grain. Sew into sets as shown.

2. Assemble 30 Unit A, and 28 Unit B.

3. To float design, cut 4, 9¾" squares into quarters, or cut 16, 6" setting triangles with Diagonal Set Triangle Ruler.



4. For corners, cut 2, 9¾" squares in half, or cut 4, 12" corner triangles with the Diagonal Set Triangle Ruler.



5. Assemble diagonal rows as shown. Combine rows. Add corner triangles.

6. Add borders. ¾", 1½" and 5" finished borders are shown.
