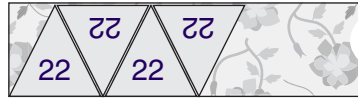
















Number of Template Pieces That Can be Cut From 1 Strip—Set G
